

Waste Collection Zones

Use waste collection points in accordance with the rules, and keep them clean. Never put out waste before the collection day or at night. Also, do not put waste out in places other than your designated collection point. Unsorted waste, waste put out on the wrong day, waste that has not been placed inside the designated bags, etc. will be left behind with an "Uncollectable" sticker. Confirm why your waste was left behind, and then put it out again in accordance with the rules.

Sort your waste correctly and put it out at the designated location by 8:00 AM on the collection day.

Do your part for the 3R's... Promoting the reduction and recycling of waste reduces the amount incinerated, leading to lower CO₂ emissions. What's important is that everyone makes efforts to generate less waste in their daily lives.

The 3R's (1) Reduce: Reduce the amount of waste generated by being careful not to buy more than needed, etc. (2) Reuse: Reuse unwanted items that are still usable by giving them to someone who can use them, etc. (3) Recycle: Recycle waste as resources.

Oversized Waste ※To be brought in directly

Bring oversized waste directly to the Clean Center after making an appointment. Bedding, furniture, heaters, bicycles, sewing machines, corrugated sheet metal, home appliances, etc. that are 50 cm or longer on one side or weigh 10 kg or more

How to dispose of personal home computers

- Bring computers directly to the Clean Center after making an appointment. You can also contact the manufacturer and ask them to collect the product.
- ※If you are unsure of the manufacturer, contact the PC 3R Promotion Association at 03-5282-7685.
- ※Be sure to delete personal data.



Appointment system

- Call the Clean Center to make an appointment for your desired date, time, and item(s). (If you want to make an appointment for a Saturday or Sunday when oversized waste is accepted, call by Friday.)
- Please note that the phone is not answered on weekends and holidays.
- Your request may be refused, depending on the remaining availability of appointments.
- No waste is accepted without an appointment.

Dates/times and location

- Oversized waste is accepted at the Clean Center on weekdays (excluding national holidays), along with the first and third Saturday and second Sunday of each month (as a general rule). Please check the "Waste Collection Calendar" for details.
- Hours are from 9:00 to 11:45 AM, and from 1:00 to 3:45 PM.

Disposal fee

- You may bring up to 100 kg of oversized waste per day free of charge. (The daily weight limit is per household.)
- If the weight is in excess of 100 kg, you will be charged 12 yen per kilogram over the limit, plus consumption tax.

- ※Please do not bring items acceptable for normal waste collection.
- ※As an exception, if you have a large quantity of waste such as when moving, you may bring it after sorting it correctly and bagging it separately by type.
- ※If it is difficult for you to bring the oversized waste yourself, the Clean Center will refer you to an authorized hauling service.
- ※When you buy a replacement, try to have the old item collected by the store where you will purchase the product.
- ※If you hire a professional service to replace tatami mats, prune trees, renovate your home, etc., ask the service provider to dispose of the old tatami mats, cut branches, debris, etc.
- ※If you bring in a large quantity of waste, the accepted amount may be limited.

※Check the Waste Collection Calendar for collection days and Saturdays and Sundays when oversized waste is accepted. Information on collection, etc. during the year-end and New Year holidays will be provided in advance via newsletters and the town's website.

Items That Cannot Be Processed by the Town

Contact a professional service for disposal.

Waste from hospitals, medical clinics, etc./construction debris/farm equipment/agricultural materials/industrial waste



- ※Batteries, tires, agricultural plastic, and concrete are accepted for a fee one day per year. Further information is provided via newsletters/flyers.
- ※Contact the Clean Center for information on where to dispose of fire extinguishers.

Items covered by the Home Appliance Recycling Act

Refrigerators
Freezers

Televisions (CRT, LCD, plasma)
Clothes dryers

Washing machines
Air conditioners

Hand over televisions (CRT, LCD, plasma), air conditioners, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators, and freezers to (1) the store where you purchased the product or the replacement, or (2) the designated receiving location after paying the required recycling fee.

How to dispose of items covered by the Home Appliance Recycling Act

- Ask a home appliance store. (You may be charged a hauling fee, etc.)
 - ※If purchasing a replacement: Ask the store where you will purchase the new item to dispose of the old one.
 - ※If not purchasing a replacement: Ask the store where you purchased the item, or a home appliance store in town.
- Bring it yourself to the designated receiving location. ※Contact the designated receiving location, and bring the item in yourself.

- Be wary of trouble with junk collection companies. There has been a rise in cases where commissioning of disposal of unwanted appliances, etc. to a junk collection company led to trouble such as being charged a large fee, or unauthorized dumping. Be very careful when using a junk collection company.
- Waste from offices and stores cannot be disposed of at waste collection points. Either bring it to the Clean Center in person (burnable waste only), or entrust collection and transport to an "Authorized General Waste Collection and Hauling Service" certified by the town.
- Flammable substances (matches, gunpowder, fuel, etc.) are strictly prohibited. Hand them over to a professional service or the place where you purchased them.

Individuals found guilty of unauthorized dumping are subject to strict punishment by "imprisonment of up to five years, or a fine of up to 10,000,000 yen."
